THE U.S. ELECTION NOVEMBER 8, 2016

According to press reports (chaps@prayinginjesusname.org, 11-10-16), 81% of those known as evangelicals on November 8, 2016 voted for Mr. Trump, who was the pro-life candidate for the President of the United States. They were also the most powerful voting block in the election. This act of unity among believers in Jesus illustrates the kind of power His followers can have when they act as one. Yet, the followers of Jesus in the U.S. are divided into thousands of factions and denominations (See Wikipedia, "Christian" denominations). In light of this, we as members of His kingdom ought to be more zealous to promote the unity for which He prayed the night before He was crucified, when He said,

"I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word; that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me" (John 17:20-21).

That unity must come in *"the kingdom of Christ and God"* (Eph.5:5) about which Daniel prophesied more than 2,600 years ago (Daniel 2:43-44), and was founded on Pentecost just ten days after His ascension, of which the same prophet about 550 B.C. spoke,

"I was watching in the night visions, and behold, One like the Son of Man, Coming with the clouds of heaven! He came to the Ancient of Days, and they brought Him near before Him. Then to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, And His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed"(Daniel 7:13-14).

Peter confirmed this on Pentecost with a quote from the Psalms,

"For David did not ascend into the heavens, but he says himself: 'The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool'" (Acts 2:34-35).

The reign of Jesus "at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens" (Hebrews 8:1) must continue until the resurrection for "then comes the end when,

"He delivers the kingdom to God the Father, when He puts an end to all rule and all authority and power. For He must reign till He has put all enemies under His feet. The last enemy that will be destroyed is death" (I Corinthians 15:24-26).

EXPECTATIONS OF THOSE IN THE KINGDOM

The Savior commanded His servants, saying,

"All authority hath been given unto me in heaven and on earth. Go ye therefore, and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them into the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit: teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I commanded you: and lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world" (Matthew 28:18-20).

With this order we realize the King has given His servants three obligations to perpetuate the kingdom, 1) Go among the nations of the whole earth and 2) Make followers (disciples) for Him and 3) Teach those new disciples to do the same. 4) Also He has further expectations of His servants by which they will strongly influence society, for He said, "The kingdom of heaven is like leaven, which a woman took and hid in three measures of meal till it was all leavened" (Matthew 13:33). Now beloved, we as American servants of Jesus must ask ourselves if we are doing enough in order to carry out these obligations or are we just holding services.

The God of heaven with the election November 8th has given those who know and love the kingdom a window of opportunity to boldly evangelize as we have never done before. To use a phrase from Isaiah, "Cry aloud, spare not; Lift up your voice like a trumpet..." (Isaiah 58:1) on this continent and around the world.
