BROTHER CHONDRO'S MOTHER-IN-LAW

Monday, October 10, 2016: 3:06 AM. This is a report from Joysingh, who is the principal of the Karbi Bible Institute, Assam NE India and a bold gospel preacher.



The report: "Chondro Engti is a farmer and a 2015 graduate of the Karbi Bible Institute. Last year he began to visit his mother-in law who was a member of the Baptist Church. He visited her and her husband often and every time he would preach to them about the original Church. The initial period covered about three weeks and she was very interested, but her husband was not willing to come into the church of Christ. So she had decided that even if he was not willing, she was, and wanted to be baptized, but while Chondro was preaching she got a very bad headache, so she decided to take rest for a while, but from that time she was very serious and unconscious and had to be admitted to the civil hospital. While there she was speaking as though she were out of her head, sometimes she would understand what was being talked about and sometimes she didn't. So while this was going on the Baptist pastor and a deacon came to pray for her, but she did not want them to pray for her. She said, do not allow the pastor and deacon or any other church leaders from the Baptists pray for me, I know now what is the truth, so I will stay with my own desire. Call me brother Joysingh and let him pray for my health. So I went to have a prayer for her in the hospital and she is a little bit alright and she was baptized yesterday. Afterwards, she said to her husband [if you do not want to come into church of Christ no problem, but do not force me to be in the Baptist church]. The husband said [I know the church of Christ and they are very good, but the thing is that why I do not want to come into the church of Christ is that they are very strict, like they do not allow anyone chew beetle nut, chew tobacco, or smoke cigarettes and many other things; and for me I cannot leave those things]. That's what he confessed and his wife said to him, [(are) those (things) so important to you or the eternal life?] And he said, [I will decide it later, because if I go to the church of Christ they will not allow me (to be) what I am now]. He may leave all those things one day, so please pray for her and all the baptized people, so that they may be faithful in the kingdom of God." Joysingh.

Note, the Karbi Bible Institute now has 53 in the two-year training program.



THE PUDUKOTTAI HOME AND SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND AND DEAF

Honor to whom honor is due. I have written recently about the above named home and Bible School, but I received this picture recently and thought it is very worthwhile to pass on. The picture, besides showing the students in their new uniforms, shows the teachers and other staff. At present there are 50 students studying in the school (Blind = Boys 23+ Girls 23 = Total 46 Blinds), (Deaf = Boy 1+Girls 3 = Total 4). The teaching staff are the six seated immediately behind the girls in their uniforms. From left to right they are, C. Paramasivem, who himself is blind and a graduate of the school. He has been a teacher of braille in the school for the last twenty years. He is married and

they have a son (19). Seated to his left is Nelson son of Masilamani. This young man is a graduate of the Dindigul Bible Institute and a one-year course from a private university in signing for the deaf. He also holds a degree in education from a local college and teaches in the public school system; and he teaches signing for the deaf in our school. Nelson's wife, Priscila, who is seated next to him, assists with the blind. Her mother, Elizabeth, sits next to her holding her grandson. She is the widow of Shunmugam who began the school in 1993 and handles the day to day needs of the home and school. Nelson's parents, who are seated on the right also work with the school. As I have written before they, too, are Peter Wilson's parents. Peter is married to Mercy, who is principal of the Bible School for girls at Chettipalayam.

WORK ON THE NEW BUILDING CONTINUES

Last month I included a picture of the holes being dug for pillars for the building at the school. These latest shots came from Nelson today (on October 15th) as I began preparing this newsletter. The first one shows Nelson and brother Subramanian, who is our maintenance man, who works full time at our Tamil



Nadu Bible Institute near Coimbatore. Though he does not have a degree in engineering, he has a superior knowledge of construction and oversees all the building work that we undertake. The picture also shows the steel molds for the foundation. The picture on the right shows the foundation poured, pillars going up and some of the inner walls of concrete block in place. Nelson is shown with his mother as they look over the progress.

As I noted last month, it will contain two floors, with a total of 4,016.25 square feet. Locally the brothers can order ready mix concrete, which costs about \$55.00 a cubic meter. (As a school project for your son or daughter you might have them calculate the difference in square feet in a cubic meter and in a cubic yard. As a further part of the project they could phone a ready mix company and ask how much a cubic yard of standard grade ready mix costs; then show their results to their math teacher.

As I also indicated both floors will be poured concrete and the walls will be built of plastered cement blocks. The cost \$114,463.13, which is based on \$28.50 per square foot, which is about \$100.00 less per square foot than what would be paid in the States. Please help as you can .

REPORTS OF BAPTISMS

James Raj Kumar, a very effective evangelist, who lives in Chennai (9 million), the capital of Tamil Nadu (72 million), South India reported by the end of August that 803 individuals had obeyed the gospel through the efforts of the evening school students in the states of Telangana, Andhra Pradesh and Tamil Nadu. There are other evening schools in other places that are also reaching souls for Christ. Not only so, but the fulltime schools in the northeast are reporting more baptisms. Here is a picture of 5 men baptized, which was sent to me on October 11, by brother Sing Terang. He

wrote, the five men seen in this picture, repented from the wrong doctrine of Believers Church and entered into the Lord's church through water baptism for remission of their sins in the Dimapur river.
