## SATURDAY BIBLE SCHOOLS

This is by any means the most effective manner that I have found to train leaders and laborers for the local churches. There are 132 such Bible schools in six states with 1,002 students enrolled; that’s an average of 7.6 students each. Previously these schools were meeting three evenings a week, but as of November, they began meeting on Saturdays.

The timing is four hours in the morning for Bible class with tests and memory work required. Afterwards the students take lunch together, then two by two they do house to house/ village to village evangelism for three hours. Besides the 132 congregations that are already hard at work in this program; last month while I was in India there were 53 other graduates (see the back page), who came forward and qualified to have such Bible schools with their congregations. I told them it was impossible for me to promise, but it would be based on the kind of support we received for the New Year.

These brothers are virtually all-day laborers, who work for daily wages. Considering this we seek \$25.00 a month aid for them or \$6.25 per Saturday; I tell them it is not for wages, but for them to have bus fare for the four Saturdays a month and a meal of beans and rice. A portion of the \$25.00 is set aside for the students to buy a bicycle at the time of their graduation. The 132 congregations which already have such Bible schools, plus the 53 (total 185) that want to begin such schools in the New Year means there will be (+\-) 1,406 students enrolled. For which as noted we need \$25.00 a month support.

The number (1,406) comes from multiplying the average of 7.6 students in the current schools by the total number of 185 churches requesting such a program. One hundred dollars a month supports four men in such Bible schools. Please help as you are willing and able; and may our dear Lord bless you for it.
